Participants are expected to complete weekly photo challenges, share their work and engage in discussion and critique.

Additional Information:

A DSLR or advanced mirrorless camera with the option to control settings is required for this class. Participants are expected to be proficient in the use their camera and to have significant photography experience.

Course Content:

The instructor will solicit input from class participants and select topics that are reasonable and appropriate for class. Topics will be selected from a variety of categories such as; Photographic techniques, specific composition techniques, editing effects, or subject matter requirements.
