Course Content:

- We will review materials used in jewelry making including cords, findings, stringing materials, tools, finishes and appropriate applications for each.
- Instructions on how to combine jewelry components using round nose pliers. Go over how to open and close jump rings, how to bend wire into shapes, and how to add clasps.
- We will learn to string beads into a necklace and how to arrange beads into a pleasing composition before stringing. Review Using Needles vs. Bending Wire.
- Use charms and other components to build a pendent.
- Learn to distress and/or alter jewelry components to add new color.
