

Comedy Course: Tactics in developing and delivering standup comedy.

This course will assist the student in exploring their past experiences to create a dialogue for humor. We all have growing up stories, be it school, family, work, travel, dating, parenting and whatever else life has put in our path.

A power point presentation will discuss some of the elements of comic development and delivery of humorous events as depicted in classic past performers as well as current performers. What did these comics draw upon? They recalled past experiences and shared them with us with humor.

So many of these life incidents are just simple daily events that can be explored with an amusing outcome. The challenges that life presents us can be funny when our perspective changes.

The final exam in this course is for the student to be able to do a stand up routine of about five minutes to an incredibly receptive audience- your classmates. Your material will be from your experiences that have been developed through the course.

For the final standup, should you have bad knees and can't stand up, seating is permitted!
