

Major Cases: Focus Delaware

This course will present and discuss the major criminal cases that occurred in our First State. The Thomas Capano Murder Trial, The Route 40 Serial Killer Trial, The Former Doctor Earl Bradley will be examined and discussed. Also, because of our proximity to the crime scenes of Washington, D.C. and Maryland, The D.C. Sniper Case will be presented. The lead Homicide Detective Investigator on this National Manhunt for the killers was a previous guest speaker and has agreed to return to speak.

Also, The DuPont environmental civil incident that inspired the "Dark Waters" movie of the same title will be discussed. In addition, scheduled presentations to include: The 911 Attacks on America, The JFK Assassination and The Attempted Assassination of Ronald Regan will be examined with a Secret Service perspective by the presenter, a former agent with 22 years with this organization. In addition, Richard Jewell-One of four innocent Americans who was a person of interests in a National Criminal Critical Incident- will be explored.

In the past, presentations included guest speakers who previously offered their unique, first hand experiences. For example, a 911 NYFD Fire Captain, and a Delaware State Trooper were previous guest speakers and spoke of their roles in cases presented.
