## Fall 2022 Course Outline

This Course is based on 11 weeks of online zoom classes; Completion of the first semester of this same course (Part 1) in Spring of 22 is NOT a prerequisite to register for this course in the Fall of 22. Different chapters/topics are read and other variations will be incorporated unique to Part II of this course.

This is primarily a reading/discussion class based on two texts:

*The Universal Christ: How a Forgotten Reality Can Change Everything We See, Hope For, and Believe* by Richard Rohr And his companion book *Everything is Sacred: 40 Practices and Reflections on the Universal Christ* by Richard Rhor and Patrick Boland

As stated above, Part 1 of the class covered the first half of each book. This current class will cover the second half of each book. Each class could stand alone both in content and requirements.
