

Knowledgeable guest speakers present lectures on timely regional, national, and international issues across a broad spectrum of topics followed by a lively question and answer session. The lectures last about 45 minutes and question, answer, and comment about 30 minutes.

Guest speakers are from area colleges and universities, governments, businesses, and non-profits, and in some cases are experts from outside the tri-state area. Class members suggest topics and speakers. As part of the University of Delaware's work to build reciprocal arrangements between Osher and the University of Delaware's Newark campus faculty and students, UDE students sometimes join UDE faculty in presenting a lecture.

A semester schedule is developed depending on speaker availability with the goal of having as diverse a group as possible of articulate, engaging, dynamic, and knowledgeable speakers lecture on a wide variety of current, relevant issues.
