

## Ikebana; the Japanese art of flower arranging

In this course, students will first learn basic arrangements in shallow or tall containers before starting to make freestyle arrangements. The instructor will email videos to students prior to each class. In the class, the video will be shown again and the instructor will provide additional directions and answer any students' questions. Students will then proceed to make their own arrangements while the instructor provides advice. At the end of the class, the instructor will critique each arrangement and teach the students subtle points that should be considered
