It is fun and inspiring to be around other artists who are actually working. Ideas are taking form, shapes and proportions altered, colors adjusted, composition improved. If your own project gets "stuck", you may be able to ask another artist or the instructor for an approach.

The Open Studio is an informal opportunity to paint, so bring your own art materials and ideas to paint, draw etc. This is a great chance to work on your personal projects and assignments from your other classes. If you find repeated interruptions and distractions at home, the Open studio can give you the opportunity to complete more art each week.

The leaders will offer suggestions or critiques if requested. However, no instruction is provided.

Please make sure to have a piece of plastic or paper to cover the desk while you paint, and make clean up easier. If you accidentally spill or mark anything you are obligated to clean up - We wish the room to be completely clean when we leave.

When the class is not full, if you are not a class member, you may ask the instructors to use a desk.
