Native American Flute

Course Description

The class takes a student who knows nothing about playing Native American Flute through weekly exercises designed to familiarize them with the instrument and the methods of playing them. At the end of the class they will be able to play from the heart as well as play along with backing tracks and with the instructor on guitar.
