

One of the larger recorder groups in America, the Recorder Ensemble of the University of Delaware Academy of Lifelong Learning, offers programs showcasing the sounds of soprano, alto, tenor and bass recorders. While the recorder is usually associated with Early Music, the ensemble enjoys a broader range of music. Programs cover music from the Renaissance period through America's Colonial period to the Broadway show tunes of today.

This course focuses primarily on building repertoire in ensemble playing and improving technique. Participants should have at least two years of playing experience or instruction. Bring your own recorder and music stand.
