Those attending will learn about Hagley's extensive holdings of corporate archives, personal papers, printed books, and visual materials such as films and pictures. Presentations by Hagley's experienced staff will vary weekly in focus, reflecting the vast range of Hagley's collections. Lectures will be different from those offered previously or will be significant revised from earlier versions; the exact list can be requested two weeks before the class commences. Lectures will emphasize recent acquisitions of manuscript materials, pictures, and moving images and incorporate illustrations from Hagley's research collections.
