SPANISH: ADVANCED CONVERSATION

Course Description

O Spanish: Advanced Conversation

The class is conducted entirely in Spanish with an emphasis on active participation. Each week, the class is invited to explore a topic and share their different perspectives, based on a reading that that is sent to the class one week in advance. A vocabulary list provides definitions and explanations of unusual words and expressions, comprehension questions for quick review, and discussion questions.

A typical lesson may include the following:
Greetings, "small talk", current events
A quick game
Summary of the weekly reading
A video clip about the topic, if available, or photos that prompt commentary
Exchange of opinions

Spanish songs, popular sayings related to the novel's themes, quotes from experts / celebrities
